*Replace with other colors. Substitute "you" with their name and other people you know.*

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## Big A Little A

Big A *(Open baby's arms wide)*

Little A *(Bring hands together)*

Bouncing B *(bounce and clap hands)*

The cats in the cupboard *(cover baby's eyes)*

So he can't see!

Peek-a-boo! I see you! *(uncover)*

*Play this silly game during a diaper change, in the bathtub, or while waiting in line at the store. As they get older, they can help with the actions. Change pronouns as needed (she, he, they, etc.)*

*Ask and sing: What else can we go under? A coat? Bridge? Roof?*

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## Little Brown Bear

A little brown bear went in search of some honey *(hands above eyes, look around)*.

He sniffed at the breeze *(sniff air)*

And he listened for bees *(cup hand to ear and listen)*

And would you believe it?

He even climbed trees! *(fingers of one hand climb the opposite arm)*.

*When you repeat it, pause longer and longer each time while you "listen."*

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## Hidden Kitten

A kitten is fast asleep under the chair *(hide thumb under one hand)*

And *(insert name here)* can't find her.

He's looked everywhere *(fingers like glasses over eyes)!*

Under the table *(peek under one hand)*

Under the bed *(peek under other hand)*

And then *(name)* found the kitten.

Meow, meow, meow! *(bounce thumb across lap.)*

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## This Little Cow

*(Point to each finger in turn.)*

This little cow eats grass. This little cow eats hay.

*(Clap hands in rhythm. Repeat with other foods besides peas and do other actions like stomping or knee slapping.)*

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## Little Seed in the Ground

*(Start by crouching on the ground, covering head with your hands.)*

Little seed in the ground

Sleeping so still.

Little seed, will you sprout?

Yes, I will! *(Jump up!)*

*Repeat, pausing longer each time before you say the final line. This chant also works well with scarves.*

*Tune: Did You Ever See a Lassie?*

Oh, I love it when you read to me, read to me, read to me.

Oh, I love it when you read to me. Please read some more.

*Change up "read" to play with me, sing with me, jump with me, hug me, etc.*

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### **I Have a Little Heart**

I have a little heart *(Place hand over heart)*  
And it goes thump, thump, thump. *(Pat chest 3 times)*  
It keeps right on beating  
When I jump, jump, jump. *(Jump 3 times)*  
I get a special feeling when I look at you. *(Point to another person)*  
It makes me want to give you a hug or two. *(Hug yourself)*

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### **I Like Tacos**

*Tune: Aloutte*  
I like tacos, tacos, tacos, tacos. I like tacos.  
They're the best for me.  
Guacamole on my nose? Guacamole on your nose?  
On my nose? On your nose!  
Oooooohhhh  
*Repeat with different foods and body parts.*

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### **Bats are Sleeping**

*Tune: Frere Jacques*  
Bats are sleeping, bats are sleeping.

Then they'll fly all around. Then they'll fly all around.

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### **Ball for Baby**

Here is a ball for baby, *(hands make ball)*
